Three copies of Abstract (200-250 words without diagram and Table) along with the duly filled in **Form-A** should reach the **Honorary Secretary**, Indian Chemical Society, 92, Acharya Prafulla Chandra Road, Kolkata-700 009, within **October 24, 2011**. Abstracts received after the aforesaid date will not be considered. Abstracts should accompany **Form-A along with a charge of Rs. 200 for each of the authors** who are not Fellows in good-standing of the Society/Members of the Institution of Chemists (India). The aforesaid paper submission fees are to be sent by Bank Draft in favour of **Indian Chemical Society, A/c Convention of Chemists Fund**. **Cheques on any Bank at Kolkata may also be accepted. Author's name will be deleted from the Abstract, if such charge is not received along with the Abstract and no future correspondence will be made to the authors in this regard.**

Abstract (Oral/Poster) must contain the Section (Analytical and Environmental/Industrial and Applied Chemistry/Inorganic/Organic and Biochemistry/Physical Chemistry), name(s) of author(s) and address. The Principal author should be marked with asterisk(*) and the author who would be presenting the paper should be underlined. Not more than two papers will be accepted from any author in single or joint authorship among all the sections combined.

Poster Specification : 1 m × 1 m space would be provided for each poster.

The Scientists-in-Charge will inform the authors regarding the acceptance of the Abstract (Oral/Poster) or otherwise of their contribution. If the intimation is not received within the deadline, the author may directly contact the Honorary Secretary, Indian Chemical Society for information.

The city has glorious history and has produced many illustrious scientists, academicians and political leaders including first Prime Minister of India, Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru.

ABOUT UNIVERSITY OF ALLAHABAD

University of Allahabad, the fourth oldest University of the Republic of India, entered the 125th year of her outstanding service to the nation and humanity on September 23, 2011. The years since its foundation in 1887 have been marked by landmark achievements in the domain of learning and an abiding commitment to high academic standards, cultivation of values and the search for excellence and perfection.

There are three distinct phases in the evolution of the University. In the first phase (1887-1921), it was a centrally funded affiliating University. In 1905 it initiated teaching and research under its own aegis by establishing the various Departments, research fellowships, libraries and laboratories. The second phase (1921-1950) began with the reorganization of the University as a provincially funded unitary teaching University, comprising its own teaching departments and the departments of the Muir Central College (which was merged with the University). In the three decades, under the stewardship of celebration Vice-Chancellors Sir Ganganath Jha, Pt. Iqbal Narain Gurtu, Professor Amaranatha Jha and Professor Tara Chand and the academic leadership of illustrious faculty, the University took determined steps to enlarge its intellectual and education ambit and gave a lead in national emancipation. The third phase (from 1950) was prefigured by the stirring address of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru to the Diamond Jubilee Convocation (1947) of the University, with a timeless invocation on the meaning and purpose of a University and the role, the Universities had to play in ensuring the development and progress of India. With the advent of independence, the University gave priority to the rising expectations of the people for wider access to higher education and keeping pace with the world in higher education, took up concerns crucial to social and national reconstruction. The Centenary Celebrations (1987) provided the opportunity to reaffirm the goal of academic modernization based on social responsibility.

The University has paved the way for the re-incorporation of the Central status of the University from the Centenary Celebration Day. This restoration of the original Central status has inaugurated a new chapter in the evolution of the University. The Central university status cleared the decks for marching ahead in all the directions. The University has one Constituent Institute namely the Govind Ballabh Pant Social Science Institute (supported by the UGC and the ICSSR and also by the UP Government) and

eleven Constituent Colleges, of which five are exclusively for women, and two (including one of the women's Colleges) are minority institutions. The College Development Council Coordinates and monitors the development of the Constituent Colleges.

ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The Department of Chemistry is one of the oldest and most prominent departments of the University of Allahabad. It has started functioning in 1872 under the principalship of Professor Harrison, who took keen interest in the development of this department. Professor Hill, was responsible for managing the teaching of Chemistry. The department was established in 1921 and since then a galaxy of eminent chemists served the department. The department has earned significant popularity not only at national but at international scenario as well under the able guidance and headship of Professor N. R. Dhar, I.E.S., and also Professor S. Dutt. The pioneering research work established flourishing research schools in the area of Natural Product Chemistry, Coordination Chemistry, Reaction Kinetics and Agriculture Chemistry. The UGC has provided Special Assistance, to strengthen the on going research work since 1977. The Department presently has on its rolls 858 under graduate students, 159 post graduate students and 40 doctoral and post doctoral scholars. The faculty of the Department comprises forty two teaching positions. All faculty members are active researchers in different areas of chemical sciences.
